Please note: the free, accessible shuttle, (compliments of the Rotary Club of Ann Arbor) will be provided from 2-7 p.m. You'll find a schedule of events on the back of this invitation. We encourage you to park at the suggested locations on the map. Thank you.

IF YOU CHOOSE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:
 Take the AAATA #22 bus to Pierpont Commons. From there a free, accessible shuttle will take you into Gallup Park to the Universal Access Playground (UAP). See the red dots on the map.

IF YOU CHOOSE TO DRIVE:

- Option 1.** Park at Huron High School or Furstenberg. From there a free, accessible shuttle will take you into Gallup Park to the UAP.
- Option 2.** Park at Huron High School or Furstenberg, walk along Fuller Road into Gallup Park at the signaled pedestrian crossing. Golf cart rides to the UAP will be available within Gallup Park as indicated by the orange dots on the map. These are **NOT** drop-off locations. **Approximate distance from Huron High/Furstenberg to the Gallup Park is .5 miles. Approximate distance from Huron High/Furstenberg to the UAP is 1.2 miles.**

IF YOU'RE BEING DROPPED OFF:
 The pink dot at the Geddes Drive entrance indicates where you can be dropped off. From there golf cart rides are available to the UAP, or you may choose to walk (.5 miles).
