

Huron River Drive, Ann Arbor.

This event, cosponsored by the Michigan Commission for the Blind (MCB) and Washtenaw Community College, will feature a variety of exhibitors who will demonstrate and discuss the latest products and services for the blind and visually impaired. Admission is free and ample free parking is available.

LARGE PRINT BOOKS BY MAIL

Beginning this spring, you will have the option of selecting titles from the Ann Arbor District Library's entire Large Print collection to be mailed to you at home for free. That's over 3,000 youth, teen, and adult titles for you to choose from!

Since these books will be coming from the AADL's collection (and not the WLBPD collection), you are required to have an AADL Library card account. As a user of the WLBPD @ AADL, you are eligible for an AADL card at no charge as long as you remain a

resident of Washtenaw County. AADL card applications are being mailed to all active WLBPD @ AADL patrons. If you do not currently have a Library card, and would like to receive Large Print books by mail, please fill out and return the AADL card application when you receive it.

A letter, mailed with your AADL card application, will contain more details on this new service. Please call if you have questions.
